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## **PUBLIC UPDATE #2**

September 2, 2020

Dear Community Members,

As we draw closer to the first day of school, and as Manitoba Education responds to the ever changing COVID19 situation, new direction has been provided to the Division. Please note the following updates/changes:

- 1. Masks:** The most recent mask direction includes the following:
  - Students in grade 4 and up, teachers, staff and visitors are required to wear masks in school.
  - Students K-3 are encouraged to wear masks.
  - Parents are asked to send their children with more than one mask each day so that soiled or wet masks can be replaced.
  - Masks will be provided for those children who need one.
  - On the bus, all students and the driver are to wear mask.
  - Anyone who is actively having breathing difficulties or who is unable to remove the mask without assistance (due to age, ability or developmental status) should not wear a mask. If a child is unable to properly wear a mask or has a medical condition that does not allow them to wear a mask, parents/guardians are required to provide written notification to the school.
  - A face shield is not a replacement for a non-medical mask.
  - 'Mask breaks' will be provided. Students will not be required to wear a mask outdoors. Teachers will permit occasional mask breaks in class when students are seated and 2 metres apart. Teachers will be permitted to remove masks temporarily while providing instruction when 2 metres of physical distancing is in place.
- 2. Transportation:** For those students eligible for transportation, parents/guardians will be notified of their child's route information and pick-up time before the end of the week. Students will be seated with a member of the household or with a student in the same school cohort. Parents are encouraged to transport their children if at all possible.
- 3. Staggered start:** For the first two days of school, student attendance will be 'staggered' i.e. they will be invited in on a schedule with half of the students attending the first day, and the remaining half of the students attending the second day. This will permit staff to support students in learning and adjusting to the many safety protocols in place in our schools. A letter from the school was sent by email to families last week. Please check your email for this information.
- 4. Learning from home:** The direction from Manitoba Education continues to be that students are expected to attend school unless they or a family member is immunocompromised.

Alternatively, parents may choose to home-school. Presently, provincial direction is that school-delivered remote learning is not available on the basis of parent/guardian choice. However, the Division is committed to providing some level of support to parents who choose to home-school. More information will follow to these families mid-September. Please contact the school office if you choose not to send your child to school.

5. **Daily screening:** Parents/guardians are required to screen their children daily. On the basis of this screening, children with symptoms are required to stay home. The screening checklist is attached to this document, and linked here
  
6. **Safety protocols:** Public Health directs the public health measures in schools. In keeping with this direction, our schools are ready with the following safety protocols: staying home when sick; restricting visitor access; physical distancing; cohorts; hand hygiene; masks; enhanced cleaning and disinfecting.
