
Safe Grad (dinner and dance) Unfortunately, at this time, we are confronted with the likelihood that the Provincial Pandemic Response Level and commensurate public health guidelines will not allow for the social aspects of Graduation events – the Safe Grad dinner and celebration – to take place this June. We have been informed at a provincial level that no applications to Safe Grad have been received nor approved by Safe Grad Manitoba.

Fundraising - Fundraising for graduations proceedings shall occur in collaboration with the school, for identified, school-sanctioned items or activities. Funds raised for graduation proceedings shall not be re-allocated to private social events, nor any substitute for Safe Grad.

We recognize how important it is to honour the accomplishments of our graduates and the support of their families. We are committed to finding creative and safe celebration activities in keeping with local and provincial guidelines.
